


SPINEBOARD AND SHORTBOARD + ACCESSORIES

Wooden rescue boards for patient rescue from the vehicle

- The patented shape (curvature) of the board does not interfere with the patient's back, minimising further spinal injuries during rescue.
- Manufactured from highly durable and very lightweight wood (WPB phenolic marine wood panels) with added protection of acrylic polyurethane.
- Versatile, all-round carrying handles and fixing holes (also suitable for high-altitude rescue).
- Radiolucent (including CT and MRI), buoyant and water repellent.
- No shelf life or durability like plastic alternatives.
- Meets CE, NFPA regulations// PHTLS and NEXUS have been considered.
- Developed and optimised by doctors, traumatologists, firefighters, physiotherapists and health care professionals on 4 continents.
- Available as standard version and as shortboard.
- Accessories for safe fixation of the patient available as an option.


